#### **Financial Report**

The year ending 29<sup>th</sup> Feb 2024 produced a \$29,176.94 loss. The availability of Grant funding for the financial year has been the biggest contributor for this, as well as unexpected costs from the show which reduced the overall profit. Moving forward we are looking at a number of other funding opportunities for the Association.

# Manawatu & West Coast A&P Association (Inc.) Statement of Accounting Policies For the year Ended 29th February 2024

- 1. Reporting Entity: Manawatu and West Coast A&P Association (Inc.) is an incorporated Society and has therefore taken advantage of all differential reporting exemption.
- 2. Manawatu And west Coast A&P Association (Inc.) is a registered Charitable trust "CC34970" and reports annually to the Department of Internal Affairs Charities Services.

#### 3. Measurement Base:

The accounting principles recognized as appropriate for the measurement and reporting of earnings and financial position on a historical cost basis are followed by Manawatu & West Coast A&P Association (Inc.)

#### 4. Specific Accounting Policies:

The following specific accounting policies which materially affect the measurement of financial performance and the financial position have been applied.

- a. **Accounts receivable**: Accounts Receivable are stated at their estimated net realisable value.
- b. **Fixed Assets & Depreciation:** Fixed Assets are stated at cost less aggregate depreciation. Depreciation has been calculated using the maximum rates permitted by the Income Tax Act 1994
- c. Goods and services Tax: The financial statements have been prepared on a GST exclusive basis.
- d. **Differential Reporting**: The entity qualifies for differential reporting as it is not publicly accountable and there is no separation between the owners and the governing body. The entity has taken full advantage of all differential reporting exemptions.
- e. **Changes in Accounting Polices**: Depreciation has not been charged on show plant and machinery as from 1 March 2004. All other deprecation has been applies as in previous years.

# AUDIT REVIEW REPORT MANAWATU & WEST COAST A & P ASSOCIATION (INC)

I have performed an audit review on the Financial Statements attached that provide information about the financial performance of the Manawatu & West Coast A & P Association (Inc) for the year ended 29 February 2024 and its financial position as at that date.
