President's Report for the 2025/26 year

It has been another busy year for the Manawatu A&P. I would like to start by thanking the committee for their hard work and contribution.

We had good numbers of entrants for the Annual Show in November, for most sections and good numbers through the gate even with a number of conflicting events around the district this year.

We have had a number of ideas and requests put to us to have included in our 2026 show which will be worked through as the year progresses.

We have just hosted the Central District Poultry Associations Annual Show and are hosting the National Alpaca Association National Show in October.

The NZ Dairy Event once again have done a good job presenting this event with increased exhibitor numbers this year.

I would like to thank Hennie and his committee for organising and running this event.

NZ DairyEvent Organising Sub-committee Report to the Manawatu A&P 2026 Annual General Meeting

Dear members,

On behalf of the New Zealand DairyEvent Organising Committee, I'd like to report to the Manawatu A&P's AGM, on the event's past year. For the last week of January, the sub-committee organised another edition New Zealand's leading dairy cattle show, the 2026 NZ DairyEvent. This year's attendance was well up on last year with over 400 animals entered for the show. Analysis of the livestream from the event showed a near doubling of viewer numbers compared to last year. Following the show proceedings from around the world.

As the NZ DairyEvent Organising committee runs its own budget for putting together this dairy cattle show, I'm happy to report that we've been able to record another surplus of \$6,009.20 to add to the overall Manawatu A&P annual result.

Over the last month or so the committee has gone through feedback that was invited from exhibitors, sponsors as well as our own observations. Some aspects of the event need tweaking to improve their contribution to the show, whereas other parts were an outstanding success. The fancy dress class was one of those that initially raised some eyebrows within the committee, but turned out to be a resounding success and a great spectacle for young and old. Our media exposure is an area that needs work and we need to improve on, to make sure we retain our funders trust in making their sponsorship dollar go the maximum distance.

The organising committee is very fortunate with, and would like to express their sincere appreciation for, the sponsors and grant funders of the 2026 NZ DairyEvent, (a list of them is printed below). Their support enabled us to put on a professional dairy cattle show on a very modest budget but still drawing international attention from having absolute top (inter)national judges and competitive dairy cattle on display.

And last, but by no means least, I want to mention our volunteer committee members. Without their work and the administrative support of the Manawatu A&P, organising the New Zealand DairyEvent would NOT have been possible. These people are true legends and their input, away from their daily job commitments, is exceptional and very much appreciated.

Financial Report

All financial transactions have been accomplished by the Office Manager, with banking authorisations completed by the President, Vice President and one other Executive Member.

The year ending 28th Feb 2026 produced a \$1581.14 loss. Profit was up 90% from the previous year. The availability of Grant funding again this financial year has been positive.

The Annual A&P Show came out with a Surplus of \$11,534.46, up approximately \$4000 on the previous year with a number of conflicting events happening the same weekend. The NZ DairyEvent in January of 2026 had a surplus of \$ 6009.14.

Annual Review

Statutory audit and review requirements

Changes to the Charities Act 2005 created statutory audit and review requirements for medium and large registered charities. The current thresholds have come into effect from 1 January 2022

This performance report is prepared in accordance with the XRB's Tier 3 (NFP) Standard. The entity is eligible to apply these requirements as it does not have public accountability and has total annual expenses of less than \$5million. All transactions in the performance report are reported using the accrual basis of accounting. This performance report is prepared under the assumption that the entity is a going concern and will continue to operate for the foreseeable future.

Treatment of GST

The entity is registered for GST and all amounts are recorded on a GST exclusive basis, except for Debtors and Creditors which are stated inclusive of GST

Income Tax

Manawatu & West Coast Agricultural & Pastoral Association is wholly exempt from New Zealand income tax having fully complied with all statutory conditions for these exemptions.

Cash and short-term deposits

Cash and short-term deposits in the Statement of Financial Position and Statement of Cash Flows comprise cash balances and bank balances (including short-term deposits) with original maturities of 90 days or less.

Fixed Assets and Depreciation

Fixed Assets are stated at cost less aggregate depreciation. Depreciation has been calculated using the maximum rates. Historic rates are used to depreciate assets acquired on or before 31 March 2005 by Inland Revenue, and applicable rates after this date.
