General Rules & Conditions

1. The **Rules and Regulations as issued by the Royal Agricultural Society of New Zealand (Inc.)** for the governance and conduct of A & P Shows have been adopted by the Manawatu & West Coast A&P Association. **It is the responsibility of exhibitors to be conversant with these rules.** Copies of the Rules and Regulations **are available on request.**
2. **Entries are accepted on the clear understanding that Rules will be adhered to.**
Arrears & Entries
The Committee reserves the right to limit or refuse any entries. If any entry is refused, entry fees will be refunded in full.
A person who is in arrears to this or any other affiliated show with regard to entry fees, subscriptions, or other fees, is ineligible to enter and compete at this or any other affiliated show. Proof of payment is required before any restriction is lifted.
Entry Refunds: Requests must be in writing, with Dr's or Vet's certificate, and will be less 25% administration costs.
3. The committee reserves the right to make any alteration in Show timetable, or to postpone the Show, or withdraw any event as may be deemed desirable.
4. Depending on entries at closing date, classes may be cancelled, split, or combined if appropriate.

6. **The RAS Resolution Process** can be found on the RAS website, as above. The principle behind the process is to deal with the matter as it comes to hand and in most cases it should be dealt with directly by the show. If the matter is in regards to a RAS official, the show may request the assistance of RAS Head Office as to how to deal with this in an appropriate manner.
7. The show would prefer that **dogs** are not brought onto the grounds; but if you do bring a dog it **MUST be on a lead and controlled at all times.** The car racing circuit and its environs are strictly out of bounds for dogs.

HEALTH & SAFETY

- “The Manawatu A&P Association is required to conform to the **Health and Safety at Work Act 2015** and any amendments; therefore you are required to carry out your work or undertaking on the Manfeild Park premises to comply with this Act. As a show exhibitor at this venue you are obligated to accept responsibility for ensuring a safe showing venue within the focus of the Act. As a user of these facilities, you are required to manage and supervise all your activities and live animal exhibits to ensure the good Health and Safety of all people involved in the show, at all times.

Health & Safety Specific Requirements:

- All vehicles, caravans and floats requiring power must have a Warrant of Electrical Fitness that meets legislation standard AS/NZS 3001.
- Any and all electrical equipment, including extension power leads, must be tested and tagged with a current tag. (Standard AS/NZS3760)
- *Vehicles and leads may be checked during the show, on a strictly ‘user pays’ basis.*
- Anyone bringing in, or in charge of the use of any motorized bike, two, three or four wheeled, must be trained in its use and must wear a safety helmet at ALL times when using it.
- As Manfeild Park is a public place, bike riders must have a current Drivers’ License.
- Quad bikes must not carry passengers, and no-one under the age of 16 is permitted to operate a quad bike.
- Motor bike riders must observe a speed limit of 20km/hour at all times, anywhere on the showgrounds.

- All Stock for Exhibition MUST be in its proper place and **ready for judging by 10:00am** Saturday.
- *All entries in Purebred Classes must be registered or eligible for registration in NZ Pig Breeders' Stud Book and no animal shall be eligible for registration unless application has been made by the breeder within twelve months after birth of such animal. All Pedigree Pigs must be identifiable.*
- *No Registration is required for the commercial classes*
- **ALL BOARS OVER 12 MONTHS MUST BE DETUSKED**
(No more than 3 weeks prior to Show)
- No more than 2 entries per exhibitor per class.
- **NO LATE ENTRIES WILL BE ACCEPTED** – please get them in before closing date.
- No pigs allowed to compete in more than one class except for classes where otherwise specified.
- No milk products to be fed to your animals at the Showgrounds.
- A condition to apply in classes for Pedigree Sows over 12 months is that if the Sow farrows before being judged she is eligible for this class and may also be entered in class for Sow with Litter.
- In Pedigree classes Sow with Litter may be entered in class for Sow over 12 months. Farrowing dates must be given on entry form where required.
- All pigs (with the exception of pigs entered in the Crossbred & Grade classes) over 12 months of age MUST be registered with a Pig Breed Society affiliated to the Royal Agricultural Society of NZ. Herd Book numbers must be stated on the entry form.
- All pigs (with the exception of pigs entered in the Crossbred & Grade classes) under 12 months of age MUST be eligible for registration with a Pig Breed Society affiliated to the Royal Agricultural Society of NZ.

Two Sows over 12 months of age, one to have farrowed at least one litter, and one Boar over 12 months of the same breed.
- 5814 Junior Breeding Group
Two Sows and one Boar under 6 months of the same breed.

CROSSBRED AND GRADE CLASSES

- 5815 Sow (8 months and over)
- 5816 Sow with Litter
Not less than 8 Piglets, age not to exceed 8 weeks at date of show
- 5817 Maiden Sow up to 8 months

PORKERS AND BACONERS

- 5818 One Pig Most Suitable for Pork, to be named
- 5819 One Baconer Pig Most Suitable for Local Market, named

COMMERCIAL CLASSES

There is no requirement to be a registered breeder for these classes.

Commercial Classes will not be eligible for Supreme/Trophy awards.
