Show gates open to the public from 9am until 4pm

The display of show birds & eggs will be open to the public until 3pm

Show BIRD entries close 19th October. Sale bird entries close 26th October.

No late bird entries will be accepted

EGG entries will be accepted up until 7pm Friday 31st October.

Show benching and egg staging 3pm to 7pm, Friday 31st Oct. Show bird uplift 3pm to 4pm, Saturday 1st Nov.

Please uplift birds promptly so the show can be packed down in good time.

SALE BIRDS to be penned on Friday 31st Oct, 3pm to 7pm, or Saturday 1st Nov until 10.30am. Any unsold birds must be uplifted by 4pm Saturday 1st Nov.

Show Class entry fee is \$4 per bird or \$2 per egg entry. Entry fees to be paid directly to Manawatū A&P Association – see entry form on last page. Eggs entered into the show become the property of the Association.

No entry fee for Sale Birds. The Club gets 20% per bird sold. A limited number of sale cages will be available on a first, come, first served basis (no cage charge). Only high-quality sale birds will be accepted – no crossbred roosters please. Maximum 3 birds per sale cage, please indicate on entry form how many cages you require

BIRD CLASSES - *Entry Fee \$4 per bird*

Open to all recognised standard breeds of poultry and pigeons. Pure breeds only (no crossbreeds).

Classes: *If more than 6 of any specific breed of chicken, waterfowl, or pigeon are entered, they will be split into a separate class.*

Open Section: for all fanciers 17 years and over

Junior Section: open to all Juniors aged 5 to 16 yr.

All Classes, in all sections: Birds placed (1st, 2nd, 3rd) will receive a special card or ribbon.

Best bird in each section goes forwards for Champion and Reserve Champion.

Champion Open Bird - \$30.00

Reserve Champion Open Bird - \$20.00 and rosette

Champion Junior - \$20.00 and rosette

Reserve Champion Junior - \$10.00 and rosette

In both Open and Junior sections: Best Game Bird, Best Heavy Breed, Best Light Breed, Best Fancy Bantam, Best Pigeon and Best Waterfowl (and any other best of specific breed which has been split into a class of its own): \$10 for Best in Open category, \$5 for Best in Junior category .

EGG CLASSES - Entry Fee \$2.00 – *ANYONE can enter. We are judging the egg, not the chicken !*

Eggs to be staged on penning night 3pm to 7pm, Friday 31st October. Entries will be accepted on Penning Night.

Eggs will be judged at 10:30am on Saturday 1st November. The public is welcome to watch the egg judging.

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General Rules & Conditions

1. The **Rules and Regulations as issued by the Royal Agricultural Society of New Zealand (Inc.)** for the governance and conduct of A & P Shows have been adopted by the Manawatu & West Coast A&P Association. **It is the responsibility of exhibitors to be conversant with these rules.** Copies of the Rules and Regulations **are available on request.**
2. **Entries are accepted on the clear understanding that Rules will be adhered to.**
Arrears & Entries: The Committee reserves the right to limit or refuse any entries. If any entry is refused, entry fees will be refunded in full. A person who is in arrears to this or any other affiliated show with regard to entry fees, subscriptions, or other fees, is ineligible to enter and compete at this or any other affiliated show. Proof of payment is required before any restriction is lifted. Entry Refunds: Requests must be in writing, with Dr's or Vet's certificate, and will be less 25% administration costs.
3. The committee reserves the right to make any alteration to the Show timetable, or to postpone the Show, or withdraw any event as may be deemed desirable.
4. Depending on entries at closing date, classes may be cancelled, split, or combined if appropriate
5. **The RAS Yellow and Red Card** – (updated 2023) *This Show supports the RAS 'Yellow and Red Card' system.* An explanation of the new rules under the yellow and red system can be found at Our Rules, Regulations and Policies – Royal Agricultural Society New Zealand (ras.org.nz)
6. **The RAS Resolution Process** can be found on the RAS website, as above. The principle behind the process is to deal with the matter as it comes to hand and in most cases it should be dealt with directly by the show. If the matter is in regards to a RAS official, the show may request the assistance of RAS Head Office as to how to deal with this in an appropriate manner.
7. The show would prefer that **dogs** are not brought onto the grounds; but if you do bring a dog it **MUST be on a lead and controlled at all times.** The car racing circuit and its environs are strictly out of bounds for dogs.

HEALTH & SAFETY

- “The Manawatu A&P Association is required to conform to the **Health and Safety at Work Act 2015** and any amendments; therefore, you are required to carry out your work or undertaking on the Manfeild Park premises to comply with this Act. As a show exhibitor at this venue, you are obligated to accept responsibility for ensuring a safe showing venue within the focus of the Act. As a user of these facilities, you are required to manage and supervise all your activities and live animal exhibits to ensure the good Health and Safety of all people involved in the show, at all times.

Health & Safety Specific Requirements:

- All vehicles, caravans and floats requiring power must have a Warrant of Electrical Fitness that meets legislation standard AS/NZS 3001.
- Any and all electrical equipment, including extension power leads, must be tested and tagged with a current tag.(Standard AS/NZS3760)
- *Vehicles and leads may be checked during the show, on a strictly 'user pays' basis.*
- Anyone bringing in, or in charge of the use of any motorized bike, two, three or four wheeled, must be trained in its use and must wear a safety helmet at ALL times when using it.
- As Manfeild Park is a public place, bike riders must have a current Drivers' License.
- Quad bikes must not carry passengers, and no-one under the age of 16 is permitted to operate a quad bike.
- Motor bike riders must observe a speed limit of 20km/hour at all times, anywhere on the showgrounds.

Disclaimer:

- By entering to compete at the Manawatu A&P Show, you are accepting and agreeing to abide by the Rules of the Royal Agricultural Society of NZ and the Manawatu & West Coast A&P Association.
- You are also indemnifying the Manawatu & West Coast A&P Association against damage(s) or injury occurring while you are on the showgrounds or its environs to participate in the Show.
The Manawatu A&P Association shall not be responsible for any loss or damage (inter alia) caused through disease or infection however arising. Each exhibitor shall be deemed to have guaranteed to the Manawatu A&P Association and have given warranty that to the best of their knowledge, each exhibit entered and brought to the showgrounds is free of any contagious or infectious disease.

Central Districts Poultry & Pigeon Club Inc. Rules & Conditions

By placing your entries, you agree to adhere to the Rules & Regulations of Central Districts Poultry & Pigeon Club Inc.

1. All exhibits must be the bona fide property of the exhibitor at the time of entry.
2. Any disputes must be lodged in writing with the Show Manager prior to 3pm on Sat 1st November and accompanied by a \$20.00 fee. This fee is refunded if the dispute is upheld.
3. Exhibitors are responsible for the correct description of all birds entered for competition.
4. All reasonable care will be taken of all birds, but the Club cannot accept responsibility for any accident or mishap whatsoever. This also applies to any carry crates/cages, or other possessions left in the show area. Return them to your vehicle if you can please, the Club takes no responsibility for theft, loss or damage of any item.
5. Once benched, no bird is to be removed from its pen (except by the Show Manager, Chief Steward and/or Judges/Stewards of relevant sections).
6. Only Judges of this show are permitted to use a Judges stick at the Show.
7. Any sick or infected bird will be removed from its pen.
8. No photos taken of birds benched at this show are to be circulated prior to judging.
9. Birds with lice will not be judged.
10. Judges have the right to withhold prizes from exhibits that are considered to be of insufficient merit. The club reserves the right to appoint a reserve Judge if necessary.
11. The Club reserves the right to decline entries for any reason (entry fees will be returned).
