Late entries incur 30% surcharge

Jumping change of class: i) Downgrade – pay nothing

ii) Upgrade – pay the difference

Showing class changes on the day: \$2 per class.

Stables and yards are allocated on a first come - first served basis

General Information for Exhibitors

Entry Fees: include the RAS Show levy of \$1.25 per entry, and are GST inclusive.

Scratching's: A 70% refund of entry fees will be given if scratching is made in writing at least 2 days before the beginning of the Show with a Vet Certificate or Medical Certificate.

No refunds will be paid out at the show (please do not ask), and no refund under \$10 will be paid.

Prize Money will be paid electronically after the show. Please ensure your bank details are correct on EvoEvents so that we can ensure your money is credited to your account.

Showing :

Ribbons to 4th place.

Prize money will be paid out as per the following:

1 – 2 entries: 1st prize money

3 - 4 entries: 1st & 2nd prize money

5 or more entries: 1st, 2nd 3rd prize money

Show Jumping & Show Hunter Classes prize money will be paid out as advertised in the schedule, thereafter 1:7 ratio.

Ground Levy of \$10 per horse/pony (must accompany all entry fees)

First Aid Levy of \$10 per rider/exhibitor first aid provided by Pro-Med (NZ) Ltd.

Administration fee \$5 per horse

Disclaimer:

By entering to compete at the Manawatu A&P Show, you are accepting and agreeing to abide by the Rules of the Royal Agricultural Society NZ and the Manawatu & West Coast A&P Association.

Each exhibitor shall be deemed to have guaranteed to the Manawatu A&P Association and have given warranty that to the best of their knowledge, each exhibit entered and brought to the showgrounds is free of any contagious or infectious disease.

You are required to comply with all Health & Safety Rules and requirements of Manfeild Park Trust and the Manawatu & West Coast A&P Association, and to keep your exhibits under control at all times. Parking:

Competitors' trucks or vehicles may only be parked in the designated parking areas or

adjacent to the Ring Road, **not** on the grassed competition surfaces. Please help us to preserve our competition surfaces. (See Map prior to the Show for Parking and Gate access). Please leave parking and camping areas clean and tidy. Use bins provided for dung and rubbish, or take home.

The truck parking area will be a shared space with loading and unloading of other animals on Saturday.

Note: The outdoor arena is not to be used during measuring

Entry to Manfield Park: via Gate 2 off Kawakawa Road.

Trophies:

Manawatu A&P retains all trophies and has them engraved each year.

All trophies are available for photographs on the day but must then be returned to the stewards.

Horse accommodation:

Horse accommodation must be booked at the time of entering and paid with entry fees.

Stabling and yards are allocated on first-come-first-served basis. Please advise at the time of entry

and booking of a stable/yard if a box is required for a stallion, colt, or broodmare with a foal at foot.

Please leave all yards and boxes clean and tidy. A cleaning fee of \$35 will be charged per box or yard left dirty.

Horse accommodation charges:

Stables	\$20.00 per night
Covered Yards	\$17.00 per night
Uncovered/Open Yards	\$12.00 per night

Refunds of accommodation paid will **not** be made unless withdrawals are notified in writing up to 48 hours prior to the commencement of the Show

Exhibitors must not occupy horse accommodation unless the allocation of same has been confirmed by the Yarding Steward.

SHOW HUNTER/SHOW JUMPING

Conditions of entry for Show Jumping and Show Hunter Classes:

Run under ESNZ Rules, but please note the Manawatu A&P and RAS Rules& Conditions are also applicable to this show, as listed. Manawatu A&P Association reserves the right to change, alter entry fees, prize money or classes if circumstances warrant it.

All competitors and persons enter the grounds and show at their own risk and must abide by Health& Safety Act 2015, and its amendments.

Show Costs/Levies

- Stables \$20, covered yards \$17 per night Uncovered Yards \$12 per night, per horse
- Ground Levy \$10 per horse
- First Aid Levy \$10 per rider – Provided by Pro-Med (NZ) Ltd
- Entries close Monday 27th October 2025.
- **Late entries received after Tuesday 28th October 2025 incur a 30% penalty.**

ESNZ Levies

- \$8.50 ESNZ jumping levy (compulsory) payable by all horses/ponies competing in Show Jumping and or Show Hunter.
- Casual Jumping levy.(See table below) Horse/Pony. Cannot compete in series classes and will not be eligible for HOY points in SH.

Horses are restricted to 1.10m and Under. Ponies are restricted to 1.00m and Under.

Horses/Ponies not eligible to start in Series Classes.

General Conditions / Information

1. All competitors will be emailed a truck / float gate pass; if unable to show at the gate, full gate charges will apply
2. Run under ESNZ Rules, Manawatu A&P Association reserve the right to change / alter entry fees, prize money or classes if circumstances warrant.
3. Prize money will be paid electronically after the show – please provide correct bank details with entries.
4. Formal dress for Ring1 and Show Hunter
5. All yarded or stabled equines must have their name, the name of the person responsible and the telephone number on their head collar and/or rug as per jumping rules 200.7.1."
6. Ring 1 will run in draw order. Late entries will start first.
7. Maximum three starts per horse or pony per day
8. Prize money will be paid out as listed, thereafter 1:7 ratio as per Article 248 SJ Rules V17
9. Classes 4114 and 4215 Sweepstake. 80% of entry fees will be paid out to place getters.
10. Scratchings / refunds must be accompanied by Doctors / vet certificate and must **reach the secretary by 5.00pm Thursday 30th October for 70% refund.**
11. **No Refunds will be paid under \$10.**
